



L'ATELIER Patterns

Wow & Hermosa Sparkle Shawl

Materials

L'Atelier Hermosa: 2(4) skeins

Sesia Wow: 3(5) skeins color A

Sesia Wow: 3(5) skeins color B

Needles: Size 10 US Circular Needles

Markers: 2

Gauge: 7 “scales= 5 ¼” wide in Pattern Stitch

Be sure your gauge is correct before starting garment. If different, go up or down needle sizes to obtain correct gauge.

Difficulty: Easy

Eyelet increase (ei): pick up the horizontal bar running between the stitch you just worked and the next stitch on the left needle. Lift the bar onto the left needle from front to back and knit into the front loop. Do not twist. This leaves a small eyelet.

With size 10 needle and 1 strand of all three yarns cast on 7 stitches, and work set up row as follows: Purl 1 row placing markers as follows: p1 purl to center 3 stitches, pm, k3, pm, purl to end

Row 1: RS row k1, inc 1, knit to marker, inc 1, sm, k3, inc 1, knit to last stitch inc1, k1

Row 2: WS row: P1, purl to marker, k3, purl to end.

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you reach 215, 263 stitches. Bind off loosely on larger needle.

Bluebell Crocheted Top

Materials

Sesia Bluebell: 10(12, 12, 13, 13, 15) skeins

Needles: Size H Crochet Hook

Locking Stitch Markers: 4

| Sizes | Bust | Length |
|---------|------|--------|
| Small | 36" | 20" |
| Medium | 40" | 20" |
| Large | 44" | 21" |
| XLarge | 48" | 23" |
| 2XLarge | 52" | 23" |
| 3XLarge | 56" | 23" |

Gauge: 18 ½ sts = 4" in Lace Pattern on Size H hook or size to get gauge: Work lace pattern below for gauge over 22 chains.

Be sure your gauge is correct before starting garment. If different, go up or down needle sizes to obtain correct gauge.

Difficulty: Easy

Lace Pattern:

Row 1: (Set up row) Sc into 3rd ch from hook, Ch3, sk3 chains, *dc, ch2, dc into the next ch, Ch 3, skip 3 chs, work 1 sc into the next 3 chs, ch3* repeat between *'s ending, skip 3 chs, dc, ch2 dc into the ch, Ch 3, sc into the last 2 chs. Ch 6 and Turn

Row 2: Skip 3 chains, work 5 dc's into the next ch 2 space, * ch 4, sk 1 sc, work 1 sc into the next sc, Ch 4 work 5 dc's into the next Ch 2 space, * repeat between *'s ending Ch4, sc into the top of the last turning ch. Turn

Row 3: *Ch 7, work 5 sc into the next 5 dc's, * repeat between *'s ending Work 5 sc's into the next 5 dc's, ch3, dc into the top of the turning ch. Ch 3 and turn.

Row 4: Dc into the top of the last dc, Ch 3, skip 1 sc, work 1 sc into the next 3 sc's, *ch 3, sk 3 chains, dc, ch2, dc into the next ch, sk 1 sc, work 1 sc into the next 3 sc's * repeat between *'s, ending Ch3, work 2 dc's into 4th ch. Ch 3 and turn

Row 5: Work 2 dc's into the next 2 dc's, ch4, *sk 1 sc, work 1 sc into the next sc, ch4, work 5 dc's into the next ch 2 space, ch4 * repeat between *'s, ending sk 1 sc, work 1 sc into the next sc, ch 4, work 2 dc's into the next dc and work 1 dc into the top of the turning ch. Ch 2 and turn.

Row 6: Sc into the next 2 dc's, ch 7 * sc into the next 5 dc's, Ch7 * repeat between *'s ending ch7, sc, into the next 2 dc's and 1 sc into the top of the turning ch. Ch 2 and turn

Row 7: Sc into the next sc, ch3, skip 3 chains *dc, ch2, dc into the next ch, ch3, skip 1 sc, sc into the next 3 sc's, ch3 * repeat between *'s ending ch 3, skip 1 sc, sc into the next sc, sc into the top of the turning ch. Ch 6 and turn

Row 8: Work 5 dc's into the next ch 2 space, *ch 4, sk 1 sc, sc into the next sc, ch4 work 5 dc's into the next ch 2 space * repeat between *'s ending ch4, sc into the top of the turning ch. Turn.

Repeat Rows 3 thru 8 to form pattern

Front and Back: Worked the same (Make 4 panels)

Set up row: With size H crochet hook, or size to get gauge, and Merino Cloud, Ch 32, then work Lace Pattern stitch above until pc measures 18(20, 22, 24, 26, 28)" repeating rows 3 thru 8 once the first 8 rows have been worked.

Center Mesh Section: (Make 2) With Size H crochet hook or size to get gauge, ch41(41, 46, 56, 56, 56)sts and, work pattern stitch below until pc measures 18(20, 22, 24, 26, 28)"

Set up Row: Work 1 dc into the 7th ch from hook, *ch 2, sk 2 ch's dc into the next ch *repeat across ending work 1 dc into the last ch., ch5, turn

Row 1: * dc into the next dc, ch 2 * repeat between *'s ending 1 dc into the last dc, ch 5 and turn.

Repeat row 1 for pattern

Finishing: Lightly steam all pieces to size. Sew Center Mesh

section to top and bottom panels for both front and back. Work 2 rows of sc across the top sections of front and back. Sew shoulder seams leaving a 10 to 12" neck opening as desired.

Measure down 8(8 ½, 9, 9 9 ½, 10)" down one each side of shoulder seams and place a marker on both sides of shoulder and on both sides of garment

Sleeves: work 41(41, 41, 41, 49, 49) sc"s between the stitch markers on the side edge of garment, then work pattern stitch below, keeping crocheting looser rather than tight.
Ch 3 and turn

Row 1: skip the next 4 sc and work (*DC, ch1* repeat between *s 4 times, DC) all into the same stitch, (1 shell formed), **skip 7 sc's work 1 shell as above into the next sc** repeat between ** across ending dc into the last sc. Ch 4 and turn.

Row 2: Sc into the first ch 1 space, ch 4, sc into the next ch 1 space,* ch 4 sc into the next ch 1space 4 times * 4 repeat between *s 4 times. Repeat between *s ending Ch4 sc into the next ch 1 space, 2 times, Dc into the turning ch, ch 1 turn

Row 3: work 1 sc into the top of the dc,* ch4, sc into the ch 4 space, *repeat between *s ending sc, into the top of the last turning ch.

Lightly steam the sleeves. Then sew underarm and sleeve seams.

Bluebell Shrug

Materials

Sesia Bluebell: 6(9, 9, 12, 12, 15) skeins used Tripled throughout

Needles: Size 19 US straights preferable

| Sizes | Bust | Length | Sleeve |
|---------|------|--------|--------|
| Small | 36" | 16" | 10" |
| Medium | 40" | 16" | 10" |
| Large | 44" | 17" | 10" |
| XLarge | 48" | 17" | 10" |
| 2XLarge | 52" | 18" | 10" |
| 3XLarge | 56" | 18" | 10" |

Gauge: 7 sts and 9 rows = 4" on Size 19 needles in St St.

Be sure your gauge is correct before starting garment. If different, go up or down needle sizes to obtain correct gauge.

Difficulty:



Back: With #19 needles cast on loosely, 32(36, 38, 42, 46, 50) sts and work in St St until pc measures 16(16, 16, 17, 17, 18, 18)", bind off loosely

Fronts: (Make 2 to correspond)

Note (always slip the first stitch through the back loop) when working the St St.

With # 19 needles cast on 16(18, 19, 21, 23, 25) sts and work as for back until pc measures 9(9, 10, 10, 11, 11)" shorter than total length. Shape neck: for the Right Front: work decreases as follows: k2, ssk, work to end. Work this decrease now, Then on every 4(4, 6, 6, 6, 6,)th row 4(4, 5, 5, 5, 5) more times. When front matches back in length, bind off.

Shape Left Front; Work decreases as follows: Work to last 4 sts, k2 tog, k2, Work this decrease now, Then on every 4(4, 6, 6, 6, 6,) th row 4(4, 5, 5, 5, 5) more times. When front matches back in length, bind off.

Sleeves: With #19 needles cast on 18(18, 20, 20, 22, 22) sts and work 1 row of knit on the WS. Continue in St St increasing 1 st each side every 4(3, 3, 2, 2, 2)nd row 5(6, 7, 8, 9, 10) times. When sleeve measures 10" or desired length, bind off loosely

Finishing: Lightly steam all pieces. Sew shoulder seams. Center sleeves on shoulder seams and sew into place. Sew underarm and side seams. Neaten front edges. Carefully weave ends.

Crocheted Twisted Pullover

Materials

Sesia Wow: 8(9, 10, 12, 14) skeins

L'Atelier Hermosa: 4(5, 5, 6, 7) skeins

Needles: Size J Crochet Hook

Sizes:

Small Fits Bust Size 32/34"

Med/Large Fits Bust Size 36 to 40" (size modeled)

X-Lg Fits Bust Size 42 to 44"

XXL: Fits Bust size 46 to 50":

Gauge: 7 "scales= 5 1/4" wide in Pattern Stitch

Be sure your gauge is correct before starting garment. If different, go up or down needle sizes to obtain correct gauge.

Difficulty: Easy

Pattern Stitch:

Row 1: SC into the first Ch, *Ch5, skip next hole, Sc into the following hole* repeat from * to the end of the row

Row 2: Ch 5 and turn, *sc into the large chain 5 space, Ch 5* repeat between *s across the row.

Repeat Row 2 only throughout for pattern

Back: With Size J hook or size to get gauge, chain 18 (20, 22)24", then Work pattern stitch above until pc measures 20(21, 21)22", then work closing row as follows: *Ch2, turn, work 2sc's into the large holes; repeat from * across to end of row.

Front: Ch 25(27, 32)36", then work as for back

Finishing: Sew one shoulder seam 3(3, 4)5" wide, then twist the front once and sew 2nd shoulder seam. This creates the front twist. Sew side seams leaving 8(8 1/2, 9)9 1/2 open for armholes.



Mystery Stash Buster Hat

Materials

1 skein Sesia Echos or Chunky Weight Yarn(Stash yarn to work with the Echos appx 100 grams to strand up to same weight as the Echos)

Needles: Sizes 10 and 10 ½ US 16” circular

Difficulty: Easy

Pattern Stitch

Row 1: With B, k1*sl1 wyif, k1; repeat from *

Row 2: With B Knit

Row 3: With A, K1, *sl 1 wyib, k1; rep from *

Row 4: With A Purl

Row 5: With C, K1, *sl 1 wyif, k1; rep from *

Row 6: With C Knit

Rows 7 and 8 With B repeat Rows 3 and 4

Rows 9 and 10: With A repeat Rows 1 and 2

Rows 11 and 12: With C Repeat Rows 3 and 4

Color A= Stranded Stash to equal Echos weight

Color B= Stranded Stash to Equal Echos Weight

Color C- Echos or Echos Print

With Size 10 needles and Color A, Cast on 60 sts and carefully join in the round, placing a marker to denote the beginning of the round.

Then continue in k1, p1 ribbing for 2 rounds, change to Color C and work 6 rounds, Change to Color B and work 2 rounds, change to Color C and work 4 rounds. Work 1 row of knit increasing 1 stitch to 61 stitches

Then change to Color B and work in Pattern Stitch above until hat measures appx 8 ¾”.

Change to Color C only (Echos), or if need be continue in Stash Stranded to Echos Weight and shape crown as follows: Working in Knit, on the next round dec 1 st to 60 stitches and place

markers after every 10 stitches from the beginning marker (you will have 6 sections)

Begin Crown Shaping

Round 1: Dec 1 st before each marker 6 stitches decreased

Round 2: Knit

Repeat Rounds 1 and 2 until 6 stitches remain

Cut yarn and draw though the remaining stitches on the needle.

Pull tight and secure end to inside of hat.

L'Atelier Bormio Cap

Materials

Lana Gato Bormio: 1 skein

Needles: Size 6 & 9 US 16" Circular Needles

Gauge: 7 "scales= 5 ¼" wide in Pattern Stitch

Be sure your gauge is correct before starting garment. If different, go up or down needle sizes to obtain correct gauge.

Difficulty: Easy

Gull Stitch

Rnd 1 & 2 : *P3, K2, sl2 wyib, k2; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 3: *P3, 1 / 2 RC, 1 / 2 LC; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 4: *P3, K6; repeat from * to end of rnd

1 / 2 RC: Slip 2 stitches to cable needle, hold to back k1, k2 from cable hook

1 / 2 LC: Slip 1 stitch to hook and hold to front, k2 then k1 from hook

S2kp2: slip 2 as if to k2tog, k1, pass slsts. Over knit stitch

Sk2p: slip 1 st, k2tog, pssso

With size 6 cast on (76, 82,) 92 stitches and carefully join in the round and work in k2 p2 ribbing for 1 inch. Change to Gull stitch pattern increasing (5, 7) 7 and work for (9, 9) 10 repeats.

Shape crown beginning on rnd 2 of pattern:

Rnd 1: *P2tog, p1, k2, sl2 wyib, k2 repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 2: *P2, work gull stitch; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 3: *P2, K2 , k2tog, k2; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 4: *P2, k1, sk2p2, k1; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd5: *p2tog, k3'; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 6: *p1, sk2p; repeat from * to end of rnd

Cut yarn and draw through remaining live stitches

World's Softest Jelly Slouchy Hat

Materials

Jelly Chunky: 1 skein

Needles: 10.5 16" Needles

Gauge: 2.25

Be sure your gauge is correct before starting garment. If different, go up or down needle sizes to obtain correct gauge.

Difficulty: Easy

With size 10 ½ and jelly cast on 56 stitches and carefully join in the round place a bOR if needed. work in K1 P1 ribbing for 1 inch, change to st.st. and continue working evenly until piece measures 6 ½ inches shape crown

Rnd 1: *K5, s1, k1, pss0; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 2: *k4, s1,k1, pss0; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 3: *k3, sl, k1, pss0; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 4: *K2, sl 1, k1 pss0; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 5: *k1, sl1 , k1 pss0; repeat from * to end of rnd

Rnd 6: * Sl1, k1, pss0; repeat from * to end of rnd

Cut yarn and draw through live stitches.
